NEEDS FOR ST. ANDREW'S:

1. Ministries
 - a. Food pantry – Served 4,700 individuals in 2016
 - b. Formula ministry
 - c. Clothes closet
 - d. Household goods room
 - e. 12-steps programs
 - i. Ministries planning to close by EOY 2017.
 - ii. Cultural issues and medical issues could be limiting to some individuals
2. Columbarium:
 - a. Looking for a home for the cremains
 - i. Trying to find and contact family members
 - ii. John Paddock, Christ Church, has offered to take the cremains and inter at their church at their expense

SUGGESTIONS FOR ST. ANDREW'S:

1. Dayton-wide task force to assist with issues so it doesn't fall all on St. Andrew's
2. Solidify future use of the building
 - a. Episcopal Youth Corp
 - b. House of prayer
 - c. New model: Wesley Center
 - i. Different ministries out of one center
 - d. Failed model: Center for Urban Ministries
 - i. Had building with no mission
 - e. Refugee ministry
 - f. Gabriel's Place – Dayton
 - g. Piggyback onto University of Dayton's Food Pantry
3. Partnerships
 - a. Connection to city investment and partner
 - b. Partnership with University of Dayton
4. Tell St. Andrew's Story – Kudos to St. Andrew's for imagining a new future
 - a. Pastoral care
 - b. "Interview" other congregations
 - c. Final Sunday on Easter
 - i. Could potentially be an issue regarding budget with pledges and deferred maintenance
 - ii. Contributions from wider community to sustain St. Andrew's to an Easter end date.
